On April 9th, 2010, the Complaints Committee met to consider a complaint concerning a member reported for stealing from a colleague. The member was dismissed by her employer. The Complaints Committee found the member guilty of professional misconduct in accordance with the Act and ordered that a letter of reprimand remain on file at the Association's office.

Furthermore, after a thorough review of the evidence, the Complaints Committee chose to act under paragraph 32(1)(d) of the Act and ordered that the member successfully complete the *Ethical and Legal Aspects of Nursing* course and to make restitution with her employer. The member was required to provide documentation proving that she completed the course prior to 2011 licensure or the member's registration would be suspended. The member was informed that she could request a hearing before the Discipline and Fitness to Practise Committee if she was not satisfied with the conditions outlined by the Complaints Committee.
